Non urgent appointments for ancillary services for the diagnosis or treatment of injury, illness or other health condition		Within 15 business days of request
Urgent care services that do not require prior authorization	Includes appointment with any physician, nurse practitioner, physician assistant in PCP in PCP's office	Wait time not to exceed 48 hours
Urgent care services that require prior authorization (SCPs)	Includes SCPs and others	Within 96 hours of request
After hour care with a PCP	Must have appropriate after-hour emergency instructions	Ability to contact on-call physician after hours within 30 minutes for urgent issues
Access to first prenatal visit		Within 5 business days of request
Access to well-child visit with PCP		Within 10 business days of request
Access to PCP or designee	Must have recording on answering machine.	24 hours a day, 7 days a week
Initial health assessment (members 18 months and older)		Within 120 days of enrollment
Initial health assessment (members under 18 months)		Within 60 days of enrollment
